Organizational Goals for the 2019-2021 Period

These organizational goals are intended to promote both the MISSION and PURPOSE of The Sons of the Republic of Texas, while also furthering the Sam Houston Chapter as a leading civic organization within the larger Katy, Texas area.

- 1. Increase the Chapter's overall membership by 15% (Membership as of Jan 2019 was 89 current members). *Assigned responsibility:* Chapter President
- 2. Increase the <u>average</u> attendance at scheduled chapter meetings to 15 or greater during this period. *Assigned responsibility:* Dennis Giuffré
- 3. Develop and publish a Chapter-level ancestor booklet. *Assigned responsibility:* Chapter Vice President
- 4. Win the *Chapter Archives Award* (e.g., Three-legged Willie Award) at least once during this period. *Assigned responsibility:* Chapter President
- 5. Place in the Top 3 for Civic Organizations in the annual Katy ISD FFA Livestock Show & Rodeo Parade (2 out of the 3 years). *Assigned responsibility:* Chapter President
- 6. Develop, publish, and maintain a Chapter-level *New Member Welcome Packet*. **Assigned responsibility:** Chapter President
- 7. Submit for a Texas Historical Commission *Award of Merit. Assigned responsibility:* Chapter President
- 8. <u>Stretch Goal:</u> Perform a Texas History activity at a public or private school. **Assigned** responsibility: Bobby R. Smith
- 9. <u>Stretch Goal:</u> Provide direct support in the placement of a historical marker for the Battle of the Brazos near San Felipe de Austin. *Assigned responsibility:* Chapter President and Kameron Searle.

Progress against these goals will be communicated to the Chapter's membership at an interval not less than quarterly on a calendar year basis. If a member is interested in supporting the efforts on any specific goal, that individual should contact the assigned responsibility individual or a Chapter officer to formally make such a request.
