



The *U.S.S. San Jacinto* has a long and storied history with the United States Navy. The current registry is the third ship to bear the name and each generation of ship has lived up to the significance of its name. The first *U.S.S. San Jacinto* was an early Frigate launched in 1850, while the second was an Independence-Class Aircraft Carrier (CVL-30), named in 1943, that served in the Pacific campaigns of World War II. The third and current ship, CG-56, is a Ticonderoga-Class Cruiser that was commissioned in 1988.

The Sam Houston Chapter recognizes two sailors aboard the *U.S.S. San Jacinto* annually via the *Enlisted Sailor of the Year* Award, which was initiated by former Chapter Presidents B. Rice Aston, Walter Nass, and others in 1989. One sailor is selected for the *Enlisted Sailor of the Year* Award, while the runner-up is also celebrated. The sailor's names are typically acknowledged during the Texian Navy Day festivities each September onboard the U.S.S. Texas in La Porte, Texas. In 2019, through an approved motion, this award was renamed the Bobby R. Smith USS San Jacinto Enlisted Sailor of the Year Award after two-time Past Chapter President Bobby R. Smith of Houston, Texas.
